
Please refer to our Notice 068/2006 11 December 2006.

During the course of today extensive communication has taken place with Qantas management regarding the proposed T1/T2 merger roster. As it stands with an optional 4-week termination clause the ALAEA has indicated that it will not advise members one way or the other regarding the vote.

Qantas has indicated that it wishes the ALAEA to endorse the proposal as is and is not prepared to proceed with the vote without ALAEA endorsement. Please refer to the following email from Murray Harris received at 1650 this afternoon.

*"As per my earlier email, given the ALAEA executive is not endorsing the roster prior to the ballot we advise we withdraw from the draft agreement, and will now consider alternatives for Melbourne ACS."*
