Some members have sought clarification on the second issue regarding 8-hour rosters. It was suggested that a time limit be placed on the result should the proposal be accepted. To further explain the reason behind the 8-hour roster question I can provide the following comments.

- The Federal Executive can already withdraw from an extended hour roster without a ballot of members.
- The result of this question does not constitute authority from the membership to take this step but rather sits as a guide to the current Executive.
- The question is being asked now as many Qantas members have requested we consider it. The Federal Executive needs feedback to determine if the view is widely spread.
- This guide will remain in place for the term of the current Executive.
- Where possible a further ballot would take place prior to actual withdrawal for those members directly affected by any decision.
