RE: CASA B3 MEETING


Members are advised that CASA has scheduled a meeting of their B3 team to be held at Jandakot on December 12 for "Industry Consultation", from 1300hrs to 1630 hrs. We are aware that this is a difficult time for most of you to attend and we are sure that CASA is well aware of this and have chosen this time to benefit their employer advisors so as to limit objections to their planned outcome. For that reason we ask you make a special effort to attend.

CASA has largely sidelined and ignored the ALAEA in the formation of their plan and are aware that we object to it on both technical and legal grounds. We have been advised that there was a plan at the outset to devise a system to lock GA LAMEs into GA so their ability to move to higher paid positions in the industry would be much more difficult.

One example is their intention to train future GA LAMEs to a price, not a standard, removing large elements of the curriculum and permitting 18 year old partly trained apprentices to be granted LAME status and issue release to service after maintenance.

If you cannot attend yourself, please ask someone who can attend to act on your behalf; your own future is at stake.

Remember, the employers are driving this with a compliant CASA management, many of whom are ex-military and do not understand civil aviation.
