RE: Cabin Air Quality

The ALAEA Federal President is a member of the CASA convened Expert Panel on Aircraft Air Quality (EPAAQ), a panel formed to investigate the potential health effects of exposure to contaminated cabin air in aircraft.

As part of it's role the panel has engaged Rumball Souter Floyd and Associates, Occupational and Environmental Medicine consultants, to obtain and document available evidence for consideration by the panel.

They are requesting epidemiology reports, safety incident reports, toxicology studies, medical reports or the like that have relevance to exposure to fumes onboard an aircraft.

If there are any members of the Association or people that they know that have been in a situation where they have been affected by fumes during their work or travel, and are willing to either document it or have some relevant documented evidence we would like to hear from you.

Any information received will remain confidential if requested.

Although the Expert Panel is focussing on contaminated cabin air the Association will also be making sure that the effects of exposure to fumes to those working around the outside of aircraft are also considered by the panel.

Submissions are requested to be in prior to the 27th July 2009.
