TO: QANTAS MEMBERS

RE: APESMA PROFESSIONAL ENGINEERS PROTECTED INDUSTRIAL ACTION

The ALAEA has been informed by APESMA that their members are commencing Protected Industrial Action in support of their claims in negotiating a new EBA.

As we understand it the nature of the action is to impose bans on working overtime, working out of normal hours, and call-ins.

Members are advised to continue to work as normal performing the tasks you would normally perform and not do anything that would exacerbate the dispute between Qantas and APESMA.

Members should also continue to apply their normal diligence in ensuring work on aircraft is not carried out unless the appropriate paperwork is in hand and signed by an authorised person pursuant to the Qantas Engineering Maintenance Manual. Members should check the credentials of those signing for such authorities against the registry of authorised personnel in the Qantas System of Maintenance. If the persons name does not appear as an authorised person (e.g. CAR35, 42, or 36) holder then the work should not be done until the credential of the person who signed is determined.
