



OneSKY – the future of Air Traffic Management

A major new initiative in air traffic management (ATM) will be the subject of a series of conferences at the Australian International Airshow 2015.

The program, known as OneSKY, will bring military and civil aviation together in one air traffic management system for the first time.

It is described as a world first and, as such, is one of the most significant and important aviation initiatives ever undertaken in Australia.

When implemented OneSKY will ensure Australia remains a global leader in air traffic management service delivery into the future.

Airservices Australia will present two specifically targeted conferences on OneSKY at Avalon 2015.

Airservices, a renowned world leader in ATM, has responsibility for 11% of the world's air space.

Each of the information sessions is expected to attract an impressive number of quality delegates from throughout Australia and the Indo Pacific region.

The first, (Wednesday morning 25 February), will be targeted at the executive and senior military management level.

The second, during the Wednesday afternoon, will be a more technical in nature.

Both sessions will address the specifics of the OneSKY Australia Program to date, what Airservices is planning for the future, and the benefits for the civil and military aviation sectors.

Civil and military aviation stakeholders from around the world, with an interest in air traffic management systems and/or civil-military harmonisation efforts, are invited to attend either or both sessions.

No pre-registration is required ... no cost admission is available to all exhibitors, trade visitors, conference delegates and invited guests. The OneSKY sessions will be held in Conference Room 4 at Avalon.

The Australian International Airshow 2015 will be staged between 24 February and 1 March at Avalon Airport.
